Essential Questions	Grade Level Scope and Sequence
Do the performing arts enhance lives? What makes a performance excellent, significant or meaningful? Do performing arts communicate emotions, express values, and describe our personal experiences? Do performing arts enhance your worship and understanding of God?	 5th Grade Music: Identify and perform music from a variety of historical and cultural origins. Sing and/or play instruments alone and with others, demonstrating a variety of repertoire, using proper technique, accurate rhythm, accurate pitch and appropriate expressive qualities. Read, write, improvise and compose rhythms, melodies and accompaniments. Identify the sounds of a variety of instruments including orchestra, band and classroom instruments. Demonstrate audience and performer behavior appropriate for the context and style of music performed.
