Dr. Mike Hayes Began his tenure as Worthington Christian School's head of school in July 2022. Before joining WC, Dr.Hayes had a distinguished career at Lee University in Cleveland, TN where he held significant roles sine 1995.

Dr. Hayes' early career at Lee included positions as Counselor, Coordinator of Academic Assessment, and Director of Student Development. He became a member of the President's Cabinet in 2006 as an Assistant Vice President and was promoted to Vice President for Student Development in 2010, the position he held before coming to WC.

Dr. Hayes has an Ed.D. (Doctorate) in Educational Administration and Policy Studies from the University of Tennessee, an M.Ed. in Counseling from the University of Tennessee, and a BA from Lee College in Psychology.

Dr. Hayes played "every sport with a ball" in Sidney, where his young life revolved around school, athletics, and church. While at Lee, Mike met his wife Angela, who is from South Georgia. 
