To declare your summer reading book, have your student log into their school account, select the Summer Reading Declaration form, enter the book title and author, and submit the form. This **MUST** be completed **BEFORE** June 30th.

Below, you will also find the criteria that your child's book must meet to be counted as their summer reading book.

You will also find another attachment. This worksheet is an optional guide to help your student with the summer reading project during our first week back. It is **NOT** required.

SUMMER READING BOOK REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ May not be a graphic novel
- ✓ Must be 250 pages or more
- ✓ Must be a 5th/6th grade reading level
- ✓ Must be read before the first day of school.
- ✓ Must be a fiction book - No nonfiction
