High School Students:

- High school students should anticipate being at school from 8:20am to 3:20pm from Monday-Thursday, May 18-21. **There is no early release on the final day of school.**
- During each exam block for high schoolers, students will have a built-in time for review at the beginning of the class period along with a time of reflection after the exam.
- Seniors with a B+ or higher in a second semester class are not required to attend that class review or exam.
- AP classes will not be in session during exam week.

Middle School Students:

- Middle school students will participate in various enrichment activities throughout exam week. They are expected to report to school at 8:20am, Monday-Wednesday, May 18-20.
- Middle school students in **high school** classes may choose to participate in the enrichment activities provided, OR they may take their exam during the regularly scheduled class time. If a student chooses to participate in the enrichment activities, they will be scheduled to take their high school exam on Thursday, May 21.
- **Enrichment Activity Schedule:**
 - **Monday** – Various service projects, picnic at Lazelle Woods Park
 - **Tuesday** – Rumpke Waste and Recycling Center, Columbus Zoo, Columbus Museum of Art
 - **Wednesday** – Columbus Clippers game
 - **Thursday** – Exams for middle school students taking high school classes (individual teachers will provide additional details). Middle school students that are not taking classes for high school credit do not need to attend school on Thursday.
